This to advise that on March 11, 2008 the following Terminal Receiving Charge was filed in its tariff by FESCO Ocean Management Limited (and its Agents) to be effective April 10, 2008:

*Rule 23-9 TERMINAL RECEIVING CHARGE (TRC):*

*Eff: 10 APR 2008    Symbol: I*

*Definitions:*

*Terminal Receiving Charge is defined as the service performed to move non-containerized or breakbulk cargo from the receiving gate to ship's tackle or end of ship's roll-on ramp. Terminal Receiving Charge includes receiving cargo from the gate to first place of rest, tallying, checking, wharfage, and delivering cargo from first place of rest to ship's tackle or end of ship's roll-on ramp.*

*Unless otherwise specified in individual TLI's all non-containerized or breakbulk cargo received by Carrier or its Agent and/or Stevedores at Carrier's terminal will be assessed a Terminal Receiving Charge as follows:*

*RUSSIA:*

*On non-containerized or breakbulk cargo received at loading ports in the United States, for shipments to Ports and Points in Russia, a Terminal Receiving Charge of US\$ 15 per W/M shall be applicable.*
